

# PARKING AND BADGE POLICY

The Anglo-American School of Moscow is an “access controlled” facility. AAS Security endeavors to provide a safe and secure environment for the AAS Community and visitors 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. In an effort to provide optimum customer service, AAS Security asks your help to ensure safety and security on the AAS Compound by adhering to the policies regarding: traffic, parking, student pickup/drop off, and badges.

## Traffic, Parking, and Student Pick up/Drop off

- AAS traffic policies are applicable to all persons wanting access the AAS Compound.
- Students must be dropped off/picked up and exit the vehicle at **CURBSIDE ONLY!**
- Drivers should remain in their vehicles at **ALL** times unless parked in the Red or Blue Zones.
- Maximum speed on the AAS compound is 10 km/hr.
- Pedestrians always have the right of way.
- Pedestrians must use the pedestrian gate at all access points to the AAS Compound. Use of the vehicle gates by pedestrians is strictly prohibited for their safety!
- **Every** adult must display his or her AAS Badge while on the AAS Compound.
- Vehicle Parking Permits must be displayed in the windshield at all times.
- Middle and High School Students are required to carry their AAS Student ID.
- Vehicles without Parking Permits will be screened prior to entering the AAS compound.
- AAS Security reserves the right to screen any persons or vehicles prior to entering or while on the AAS compound.
- All drivers must follow instructions from AAS Security at all times.
- AAS reserves the right to make policy changes without notice.
- The Parking Permits are registered to a specific car. Please, inform AAS Security of any changes in vehicle information.

## Parking Zones

**RED ZONE PARKING:** Red Permit holders are authorized to park in the Red Zone for up to **5 minutes**. Hours: 07:00-09:00 & 15:00-16:30. Wednesdays: 07:00-09:30 & 15:00-16:30. Parking is not permitted in the Red Zone at any other times.

**BLUE ZONE PARKING:** Only Parent Badge holders with a Blue or Red Permit may park in the Blue Zone for 1 hour from 07:00- 18:00. Helper Badge holders with a Blue Parking Permit are not permitted to park on the AAS Compound.

**Parking Permits & Badges may be revoked or suspended for violations or the commission of a dangerous act.** Examples: Speeding (10km/h max.), Reckless driving, Disregarding Guard instructions, Dropping off passengers in the middle of the road (not at curbside), Use of a horn, Use of profanity, Fighting, Intimidation, etc...

## Badges

- **EVERY ADULT MUST DISPLAY THEIR AAS BADGE AT ALL TIMES WHILE ON THE AAS COMPOUND.** Only parents and grandparents are eligible to receive a “PARENT” badge.
- MS & HS Students must show a Pokrovskiy Hills Badge to enter PH’s from the AAS Compound.
- MS & HS Students must show an AAS Badge to enter the AAS Compound from Pokrovskiy Hills and all other access points.
- Helper Badge holders are not permitted on the AAS Compound between the hours of 08:45 to 15:15 (Wednesdays 09:30-15:15).
- Helper Badges must be returned to AAS Security prior to issuance of a new badge regardless of reason. It is the responsibility of the Parent requesting issuance of a Helper Badge to collect and return badges from discharged Helpers (Nannies, Drivers, etc...)
- A maximum of 3 Helper Badges per Student.
- Students that exit the AAS compound at **ANYTIME** will not be permitted re-entry unless accompanied by a Parent, Helper, or authorized by their respective principal.
- Students exiting the AAS Compound during normal school hours **MUST** have a Permission Slip from their respective school. \*This rule applies even if accompanied by a Parent.
- Students should leave the AAS compound at the end of the school day or at the conclusion of after school activities.
- All students must leave the AAS Compound by 6pm (unless attending a school sponsored function).
